

Notes for completing this form

Part 1 Please give your new / present address here. If your new address is not in Newcastle upon Tyne please contact the appropriate Electoral Registration Officer for a form. Please give telephone / email address details in the space provided so that we can contact you if there is anything unclear on your form.

Part 2 Please give your previous address if you have moved within the last 12 months. If you know the name of the council for your last address please put this in the box provided and we will let them know that you have moved to Newcastle upon Tyne.

Part 3 Please list the names of all eligible residents who live at this address. **Do not** include people under 16, Foreign Nationals (other than British, Irish, Commonwealth, and European Union Citizens) or anyone currently serving a prison sentence.

If any resident is a European Union Citizen (other than Britain, Ireland, Cyprus or Malta) please give their nationality in column A. The member states of the European Union are Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain and Sweden.

Please give the date of birth in column B of any 16 or 17 year olds, so that they will be able to vote at elections when they reach 18 years of age.

Please put an 'X' in column C if any resident is over 70. People aged 70 and over are not eligible for Jury Service.

If anyone listed overleaf would find it more convenient to vote by post please put an 'X' in column D opposite their name, ballot papers will be sent to this address for all elections until Electoral Services are informed that it is no longer required. If anyone would like the ballot paper sent to a different address, or would like to appoint someone to vote on their behalf (a proxy), please contact Electoral Services for the appropriate form.

Two Versions of The Register.

The full Register of Electors lists everyone who is entitled to vote. It is available to check, under supervision, at the Civic Centre, the Central Library and some local Libraries. It is also used by other organisations for prevention and detection of crime and checking your identity when you apply for credit. The law says who can have a copy of the full register and what it can be used for.

The Edited Register is available for sale to anyone that requests a copy and can be used for any purpose. If you do not want your name to be sold onto anyone please place an 'X' in column E of part 3. All occupiers must be asked individually if they want to opt out of the Edited register.

Each person added must sign the form opposite his or her name. Names will not be added to the register and the form will be returned to you if each individual applicant does not sign it.
